



## Rules for Weapons and Licenses at the Boarder:

Canadian boarder regulations require, in addition to your passport or birth certificate and photo id, you have to have a hunting license from the previous year or current year from your native nation, a weapon declaration form and trigger locks on all semi-automatic weapons.

## What to Bring for the Hunt:

- Sighted rifle or bow
- One full box of ammunition or 6-12 arrows w/ field point tips and broad-heads
- A good pair of lightweight binoculars
- Sunglasses
- Chapstick
- Flashlight w/ extra batteries and/or lantern
- Hunting rain outer gear
- Warm hunting outer gear
- Non-cotton long underwear
- Non-cotton warm socks
- Non-cotton layered clothing
- Solid hunter orange vest or jacket and hat
- Warm hunting hat w/ ear flaps
- Warm (waterproof) hunting boots
- Hiking shoes and comfortable shoes for around camp
- Jeans for around camp
- Comfortable shirts for around camp
- Socks and underwear
- Personal needs
- *Trigger lock for semi-automatic guns – Must have!*
- *Forms for transporting weapons into Canada – Must have (available at boarder)!*
- *Hunting license from previous year or current year -Must have!*
